

Mountain View, as it is currently called (pending pastoral reorganisation, after which it will be the parsonage of the new parish) is on Gardener's Lane in Ramsey, beside the River Sulby.

It is a beautiful modern home in a stunning location, with birdsong and delightful views.

And, before I further channel my inner estate agent, let me say that it is ideally located to be the home of the Incumbent for the proposed new parish, combing the existing parishes of Bride, Lezayre & N. Ramsey (BLNR) with Maughold & S. Ramsey.

It is our diocesan policy to ensure that a home can be moved into without major works on behalf of the new priest, although we do allow clergy and their families to make their own mark on the home, of course. But we will clean the house thoroughly and steam clean all carpets. If need be we replace worn carpets in essential rooms (you can see the details in "A Guide to living in a parsonage: making the Vicarage your home" on the diocesan website.)





There are one or two modifications we need to make to ensure the Vicarage family's privacy.

As well as a lovely house with 5 bedrooms and *en suite* bathroom etc, there is a small bedsit over the double garage. The DBF have designated this as accommodation for a youth or children's minister.
